VIC Junior Ready-to-Race Clinics Wrap-up

The weekend of 2-3 July saw 50 junior paddlers attend specialised flatwater race clinics run by Olympic and World Championship paddlers Cat McArthur, Mick and Kate Leverett and Reka Abraham at Lake Weeroona in Bendigo. Cat, Mick, Kate and Reka were supported by nine coaches from Victorian clubs: Rachel de Kretser, Paul Kristian, Wen Tan, James Humphry, Chris Burns, Louise Greenwood, Hamish Young, Alex Boyd and Jake Reinits.

Four clinics on Day 1 focused on technique, body rotation, fast starts and wash riding, with breaks between the clinics to participate in the Victorian Short Course Marathon Championships races. The day concluded with medal presentations and a pizza night at Bendigo Canoe Club.

On Day 2 the clinics focused on teamwork, doubles paddling and K4. The team boat sessions were followed by a doubles short course race, where paddlers had the opportunity to implement what they had learned.

The weekend finished with a TK2 relay race, in which junior paddlers were divided into teams of four and partnered with a coach or former Australian Marathon team member.

Over 90 paddlers participated in the clinics and short course championships, with 50 juniors from Victoria and Tasmania participating in 22 separate clinic sessions; in addition to five short course events over the two days.

Thank you to all those involved in making the event a success, from the PV Marathon and Bendigo Canoe Club for organizing and hosting the event; Cat, Mick, Kate, Reka and the nine coaches for session delivery; the race officials for keeping the show on schedule; Bendigo Canoe Club volunteers for venue setup, on-water safety and catering; for the parents and coaches for preparing their paddlers and attending the weekend, and to the City of Greater Bendigo for their sponsorship.
